

PATCH. MEND. SUSTAIN

LEARN TO CREATIVELY MEND OR REPURPOSE WORN PIECES INTO SOMETHING BEAUTIFUL AND UNIQUE.

WHETHER FIXING, PATCHING, OR REIMAGINING, EVERY STITCH REDUCES WASTE, PROMOTES SUSTAINABILITY, AND SPARKS CREATIVITY.

REPURPOSE OLD CLOTHING

Have a shirt that doesn't fit any longer? Have a skirt or a pair of shorts that have holes in them you can't mend? Use the clothing to create patches!



CREATE MINI PATCHES FROM FELT

Wool felt can be repurposed from old wool blankets or even old socks. The felt can be used to create new patches to decorate or mend clothing.



PERSONALIZE WITH PATCHES

Personalize something using repurposed fabrics. Either for yourself, a gift for someone else, or just keeping track of your children's items.



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FABRIC PATCHES

- 1) Cut the shapes you'd like out of the fabric backed with fusion paper. Use the paper side to draw out your shape if needed.
- 2) Take shapes home.
- 3) Check that the item you want to iron the patches onto is safe for an iron. 100% cotton material works best. Thinner material which does not stretch is preferable.
- 4) Peel off paper backing, and place fabric side up. Iron on to clothing, pillow cover, scarf, etc...



FELT PATCHES

- 1) Cut felt into desired shape.
- 2) Embroider design.
- 3) Cut fusion paper to size to take home if you wish to have fusion paper for your felt patch. It is NOT necessary if you prefer to stitch your patch on instead.
- 4) Take patches home.
- 5) If you are using fusion paper, at home iron the rough side on to the back of your felted design.
- 6) Check that the item you want to iron the patches onto is safe for an iron. 100% cotton material works best.
- 7) Peel off paper backing, and place design side up. Remove the paper. Iron on to clothing, pillow, scarf, etc...
